#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

This is a word version of a survey conducted using an electronic data collection platform which incorporated automatic skip patterns and score calculations.

To ease comparison between data at different study sites if questions are removed from the survey for one site, the numbering will have been unchanged and so some skips in the numbering is to be expected.

MA- Multiple answers allowed. SA - Single answer only.

Data will be collected in 800 HH using an electronic data collection platform. This word document represents the questions to be asked. Not all questions will be asked to all participants- many skips are built in according to fuel use, awareness level groups.
